



Wound Infection in Clinical Practice 2022, authored by the International Wound Infection Institute (IWII) Committee.

This edition authored by the International Wound Infection Institute (IWII) Committee, is an update from our previous consensus document published in 2016. Advances in research and clinical practice relating to the wound environment, risk factors for infection, biofilm, antimicrobial resistance, and new technologies for identification and management of wound infection have been incorporated into this update.
